Quick Start

A Plug In

1. If you have an existing router, unplug its Ethernet connection from your modem.
2. Screw the 3 antennas into the top of your Wi-Fi Connect.
3. Plug one end of the provided Ethernet cable into your modem and the other end into the blue port on the back of your Wi-Fi Connect.
4. Unplug the power cord from your modem for 10 seconds, and then plug it back in.
5. Plug the power cord into your Wi-Fi Connect.
6. Press the **Power Button** located on the back of the Wi-Fi Connect.
7. Wait about 1 minute until your Wi-Fi Connect's blue indicator lights are solid.

B Connect Your Phone

1. Scan available Wi-Fi networks on your device.
2. Select the Wi-Fi Connect network:
 - ASUS_(4-digit ID)
3. Enter the unique password found on the label located on the bottom of your Wi-Fi Connect.


Keep Your Existing Devices

Keep Your Existing Devices Connected Without Changing their Settings

Option 1:

Replace your existing router with your new Wi-Fi Connect


Personalize your Wi-Fi Connect's network name and password to match your old network. Please refer to the Technical Guide for more information.



Option 2:

Use your existing router with your new Wi-Fi Connect

Plug an Ethernet cable from your existing router's Internet port into one of the yellow ports on the back of the Wi-Fi Connect.




Activate Wi-Fi Calling

Activate Wi-Fi Calling on Your Android™ Smartphone

When Wi-Fi Calling is on, your smartphone automatically switches to Wi-Fi calling mode.

1. From the Settings menu, tap **Wi-Fi Calling**.
2. Confirm your location details and tap **SAVE**.
3. After provisioning, connect to the Wi-Fi network you created when setting up your Wi-Fi Connect.



Note: The Dial key will change to reflect that Wi-Fi Calling is enabled.

Activate Wi-Fi Calling on Your iPhone®

When Wi-Fi Calling is enabled, your iPhone will automatically switch to Wi-Fi Calling mode when it is connected to the Wi-Fi network.

1. From the Settings menu, tap **Phone > Wi-Fi Calls**.
2. Tap the **Allow Wi-Fi Calls** switch to toggle it to the ON position and then tap **Turn On**.
3. Confirm your location details and tap **Submit**.
4. After provisioning, connect to the Wi-Fi network you created when setting up your Wi-Fi Connect.

Note: The status bar will display **Sprint Wi-Fi** when in Wi-Fi Calling mode.
